- Drought tolerant
- Encourages pollinators
- Native to Colorado
- Fire Resistant

Many drought tolerant plants are fire resistant too because they have long roots.

3-5 feet way from home only rocks and succulents

Deer resistant

- Scott's Sugarbowl (bees like) (Deer Resistant)
- Orchid Penstemon (Deer Resistant)
- White Tufted evening primrose (Deer Resistant)
- Nodding Onion (Deer Resistant)
- Desert Sandwort (hardy) (Deer Resistant)
- Lamberts Locoweed (Deer Resistant)
- Windflower (bees like) (Deer Resistant)

Watering Options:

- Direct a downspout to flower garden
- In 2016 House bill 16-1005 allows you to collect rainwater up to 110 gallons at a time

Mulch –

- No wood.
- Pea gravel is great

Shrubs –

- Rock Spray
- Chock Cherry (may turn into hedge)
- Golden Currant
- Shrubby Cinquefoil
- Boulder Raspberry
- Woods Rose (may turn into hedge)

Other Plants-

- Golder Banner (good on hillsides)

- Sulfur Flower
- Silver Lupine (good with the not so great soil of Colorado)

Deer resistant plants –

- Penstemon (attract bees)
- Prairie Smoke (attract bees)
- Golden Banner (attract bees)
- Silver Lupine (attract bees)
- Native Yarrow (attract bees)
- Bee Balm (attract bees)
- Pearly Everlasting (attract bees)
- Black Eyed Susan (attract bees)
- Redtwig Dogwood (May need some water to get it started)
- Russian Sage (Not native to Colorado)
